

CTPAT Program / Corporate Statement of Support



Implemented in November 2001 by U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP), CTPAT is a voluntary public-private sector partnership program that builds cooperative relationships to strengthen international supply chains and improve United States border security. CBP requests that participating businesses ensure the integrity of their security practices and communicate their security guidelines to business partners throughout the supply chain.

As an importer/exporter, Quirch Foods, LLC, together with its executive management and investors, is committed to participating in the CTPAT program. Recognizing the importance of this partnership, it is the policy of Quirch Foods, LLC to:

- Ensure the secure import of goods by implementing, following, and maintaining multi-layered security procedures and practices consistent with the CTPAT Importer Security Criteria.
- Communicate applicable security requirements to contractors, service providers, and others associated with the company.
- Provide a safe and secure environment for employees, customers, vendors, visitors, and goods.
- Identify security vulnerabilities and take corrective action to mitigate risks.
- Notify and cooperate with CBP and/or appropriate authorities in the event of a supply chain security breach or suspicious activity.
- Review, revise, and update security practices and procedures on an annual basis, or as needed.

Quirch Foods, LLC believes that supply chain security is a shared responsibility. All employees, contractors, service providers, visitors, and others are expected to comply with the CTPAT Importer Security Criteria, as well as all policies, procedures, and instructions issued by Quirch Foods, LLC.
